Holt Summer Study Abroad Scholarship

The **Holt Summer Scholarship** is *merit based*, requiring a minimum grade point average of **3.0** in general scholarship and **3.30** in the foreign language.

A limited number of Holt Scholarships are available to help students fund summer study abroad. Preference will be given to students who are majoring or minoring in an LAIS or MLC program or whose courses for the summer abroad program will transfer automatically for LAIS or MLC.

Only students participating in one of the approved study abroad programs (see list below) who meet the minimum GPA criteria are eligible to apply.

Because of the highly competitive nature of the application process, be aware that **clear, specific and thoughtful answers** to application questions will help determine the awards selection.
