Holt Summer Study Abroad Scholarship

The **Holt Summer Scholarship** is *merit based*, requiring a minimum grade point average of **3.0** in general scholarship and **3.30** in foreign language.

A limited number of Holt scholarships are available to help students fund summer study abroad. Preference will be given to students who are majoring or minoring in MLC or LAIS programs or whose courses for the summer program will transfer automatically to MLC or LAIS. **Only students participating in one of the approved study abroad programs (see list below) and who meet the minimum GPA criteria are eligible to apply.**

Because of the highly competitive nature of the application process, be aware that *clear, specific* and *thoughtful answers* to application questions will help determine the award winners.

Approximate scholarship amounts: \$2,000. per semester
